THE NAME OF THE "MILLION DOLLAR CLUB" AWARD AND THE "MULTI-MILLION DOLLAR CLUB" AWARD ARE NOW "AWARD OF EXCELLENCE," WITH FOUR DESIGNATED LEVELS OF ATTAINMENT:

<u>Dollar Volume</u>	or	<u>Number of Transaction Sides</u>	<u>Designation</u>
\$2 Million	or	25	Bronze Medal
\$4 Million	or	50	Silver Medal
\$8 Million	or	100	Gold Medal
\$16 Million	or	200	Platinum Medal

- ❖ **Bronze and Silver Medal Designations** will be awarded similar to the previous Million and Multi-Million Dollar awards, i.e., by application of the awardee, in presenting documentation of the actual dollar and/or transaction volume.
- ❖ The **Gold and Platinum Medal** designation will be awarded by application of the awardee without documentation, but with written confirmation by their Broker/DR. (The Awards Committee reserves the right to require documentation, if the qualification is questionable.)
- ❖ **"Life Membership"** will be awarded after 3 consecutive years of performance at the designated level.
- ❖ **"Life Members"** of the past "Million Dollar Club" and "Multi-Million Dollar Club" are to be considered Life members with the new designations, respectively. They will receive the corresponding certificates upon request.
- ❖ It is not necessary to receive "Life Membership" at one level in order to qualify for an award at a higher level.

- ❖ **Margaret Martin Cooperative Spirit Award:** Presented to one REALTOR® who has made a notable contribution to the Association and the Community and exemplifies the Cooperative Spirit of a REALTOR®. Only one nominee from each company may be submitted.
- ❖ **Rookie of the Year:** Presented to one REALTOR® who has proven their diligence by selling, leasing, and/or listing 1 million dollars of property **the first 12 months in the business.** (Licensed assistants are **not** eligible.)
